

IN OBTAINING THIS OPERATOR'S PERMIT, I UNDERSTAND THAT I MUST COMPLY WITH CURRENT LAW, WHICH REQUIRES THAT I BE A U.S. CITIZEN TO SERVE AS MASTER OR OFFICER IN CHARGE OF A DECK WATCH ON A U.S. DOCUMENTED FISHING VESSEL FISHING INSIDE THE EXCLUSIVE ECONOMIC ZONE.
